BASIC CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT ACT, NO. 75 OF 1997

INVESTIGATION NOTICE, FISHING SECTOR, SOUTH AFRICA

I, Mildred Nelisiwe Oliphant, Minister of Labour, give notice in terms of section 52 (3) of the Basic Conditions of Employment Act, 1997, of the commencement of an investigation into minimum wages and conditions of employment in the Fishing Sector, falling outside the scope of the Fishing Bargaining Council as well as the Statutory Council for the Squid fishing sector, South Africa.

The terms of reference for this investigation shall be:

“ to determine the feasibility of establishing a sectoral determination regulating minimum wages and conditions of employment in the fishing sector, falling outside the scope of the Fishing Bargaining Council and the Statutory Council for the Squid Fishing sector, South Africa.”

Interested parties are hereby given the opportunity of making written representations. Such representations should reach the Director: Employment Standards Directorate, Department of Labour, Private Bag X117, Pretoria, 0001, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
