In terms of Regulation 10(2) of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences and Special Temporary Authorisations of 2010, as amended, Government Gazette No. 39871 of 2016 ("the Processes and Procedures Regulations"), an application to renew an individual licence must be submitted to the Authority no earlier than twelve (12) months and no later than six (6) months prior to the expiry of the licence.
