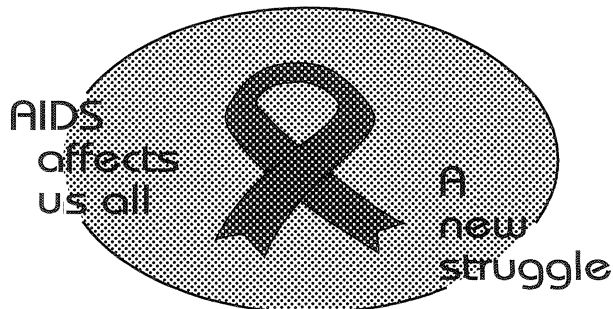

INCREASE OF SHARE CAPITAL OF MAYIBUYE TRANSPORT CORPORATION IN TERMS OF THE
CORPORATIONS TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS ACT (ACT 12 OF 1995) (EASTERN CAPE)**

I, **Weziwe Tikana**, Member of the Executive Council responsible for Transport in the Province of the Eastern Cape, in consultation with the Member of the Executive Council responsible for Finance, acting in terms of Section 5(a) of the Corporations Transitional Provisions Act (Act 12 of 1995) (Eastern Cape), hereby increase the share capital for Mayibuye Transport Corporation, established in terms of the Ciskeian Corporations Act (Act 16 of 1981) (Ciskei), from R120 million to R250 million with effect from 1 April 2014.
