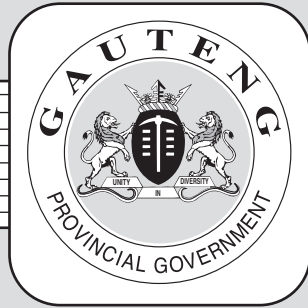

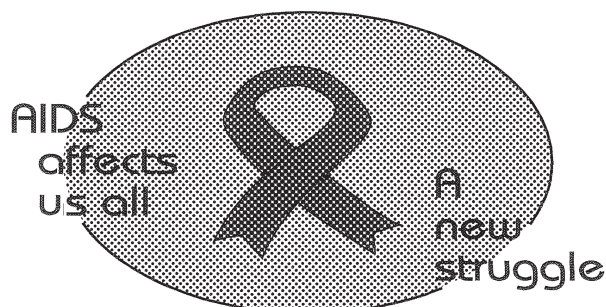

This will improve billing efficiency, accuracy, impact and improved collection of revenue. - Enable the municipality to perform reconciliations easily between its systems and assist with accurate reporting on properties and property rates. - Improve accounting for transactions on property rates and improve the control environment over such transactions.
