**LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, 1995****INTENTION OF CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION OF A TRADE UNION**

I, **Lehlohonolo Daniel Molefe**, Registrar of Labour Relations, hereby, in terms of section 106(2B) give notice of my intention to cancel the registration of **Association of Mineworkers and Construction Union (AMCU) (LR 2/6/2/974)** for the following reasons:

- The trade union has ceased to function in terms of its constitution; and
- The trade union is not a genuine trade union as envisaged in the Act.

All interested parties are hereby invited to make written representations as to why the registration should not be cancelled. **Only representations pertaining to this Notice and the following case number: 2019/53 will be considered.**
