

- (5) The information shall be based upon the determination of the stability of the ship by means of an inclining experiment witnessed by a surveyor from the Authority or person authorised by the Authority.
- (6) Any vessel, which is subject to these Regulations, which does not have a stability book, approved by the Authority, on board shall be considered to be unseaworthy and as such the vessels safety certificate, as required by regulation 8, may be cancelled.

46. Form of Stability Information

- (1) A suitably qualified person recognised by the Authority as competent to provide the required information in a clear and comprehensive manner shall draw up stability information.
- (2) The content of stability books shall be as is laid down in Annex 2 of these Regulations.

47. General Intact Stability Criteria

- (1) Vessels shall comply with the following criteria in all operational load conditions:
 - (a) The area under the righting lever curve (GZ curve) shall not be less than 0.055 metre radians up to an angle of heel of 30 degrees
 - (b) The area under the righting lever curve (GZ curve) shall not be less than 0.090 metre radians up to an angle of heel of 40 degrees or the angle of
